

Two Remarkable PROPHETS of the 20th Century

Indeed, these two men from radically different backgrounds nailed it for our times; the first was George Orwell, a journalist, who in clear unambiguous language - unlike the convoluted babble of biblical or religious 'prophets' -- spelled it out in no uncertain terms. Today we live in Orwell's 1984 on steroids, a sad indictment of the masses that allowed it all to transpire -- who could rationally dispute Orwell's remarkable and precise evaluation of western society's trajectory?

The other case was more traditional in the psychic sense, Edgar Cayce, known as the "sleeping prophet," as his many revelations and medical diagnoses and prescribed cures, were done in a self-induced trance. Cayce stated in the 40's that arctic Siberia and the current arctic regions of Canada would become the "breadbasket of the world!"
